Dear Parents,

We are finally able to carry out the traditional theme week *Ansvar for medmennesket og verden*. Some of you may remember *Rope of hope* (2011), *Be the change* (2013), *10 days of giving* (2015), *Let it grow* (2017) and *Move it* (2019).

This year the theme is *Ucycle, we-cycle, recycle* as the idea of sustainability and recycling is central. We will be raising money for two charities this year; SOS Børnebyerne and Caritas' work in Ukraine. The earnings will come from entrance fees (20 kr. pr adult) at the market on Thursday as well as sale of products, drinks and food.

The learning goals for the week are:

- For the students to understand the necessity of all of us taking responsibility for humans and the world.
- For the students to experience the joy of giving and the joy of helping others.

Students will be in mixed groups across classes in the pools 0. klasse, 1.-5.klasse, 6.-8.klasse. They will be working in workshops producing sustainable products from recycled materials. 9.-10. Klasse have an alternative project week. If you are a parent in those classes, you will hear more from the class teachers.
